In 1916, Harry H. Havens of Grand Rapids, Mighigan, completed construction of a two story building on Main Street between the Boulavard and Adams Street.

One of the store rooms was arranged to be occupied by The United States Post Office, with Gerber DeVries acting as postmaster. He had held this position since the Post Office was established using a wooden shoe box, furnished by Rollo Draft from his hardware store. (Melvin Draft is the son of Rollo Draft)

This building has undergone many changes by many owners since that time. It later became known as the Chasco Inn and is now owned by Margaret Weiskopf who operates a travel agency at the location.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO WPHS BY-LAWS

ARTICLE III - Membership, Voting, Dues

Section 3: Membership dues will be payable on January 1st of each year. The dues year will be January 1st through December 31st. The dues are as follows:

\$ 8.00 - Individual

\$ 10.00 - Husband & Wife

\$ 20.00 - Patron, per individual

\$ 25.00 - Organization

\$100.00 - Life, per individual

Each class of membership is payable in a lump sum.

Section 3A: A member joining after July 1st of a calendar year shall pay half the usaul due fees until the next dues year beginning January 1st.

ARTICLE IX - Purchases and Expenditures

Section 1: A maximum purchase or expenditure of \$50.00 per quarter may be made by the President and Curator for expenses each deems necessary. Any expenditure exceeding this amount must be approved by the Board. A telephone poll of the Board will be acceptable in an emergency. Four (4) members of the Board shall be considered a quorum vote to pass emergency matters.




